Emergency Protocol

Information For Parents/Guardians

In the event of an Emergency:

- A 3-horn blast will sound
- All Children's Divisions will implement a modified lockdown:
 - The staff will keep the children calm, close and lock all doors.
 - The Leader of each division must remain with their division.
 - The staff will continue the program as far as possible – keeping the children calm.
 - The staff will wait for instructions from the On-Site-Coordinator.
- The On-site Coordinator will share instructions and information as received from Emergency Operations Centre.
 - They will be located outside of the division buildings/tents, along with additional security personnel.
 - They will let the tent divisions know should the need arise to move their children into buildings.
 - 9-10 will move to 5/6 building
 - 11-12 will move to 7/8 building
- A Paid staff person in each division will be designated to tune to 90.1 FM as well as their portable radio to listen for further information and/or instructions.

In the event of an evacuation:

- This instruction will be communicated via the 90.1 FM radios.
- Parents will be asked to pick up children from their division buildings. Child pick-up rules will apply as usual.
- Parents who have accompanied their children to their respective meetings, can exit with their child/children at any time. Staff will monitor this at the exit doors.
